However, applicants are encouraged to check the University Calendar in order that they avoid to apply for periods that are not eligible (e.g. summer holidays).
- 3. In order to achieve the optimal number of mobilities, we are planning to open an new call for any remaining mobilities in early November 2018. We expect that any cancellations will have been concluded until that period and will be able to proceed as planned.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

[Information for the Nominees wishing to apply]

- 1) All **nominated** staff members will be sent **guidelines** for the necessary documentation.
- 2) In order that nominees submit their applications, the nominees have to prepare the following documents:

a) The MOBILITY AGREEMENT for Teaching

The Mobility Agreement must:

- a) Include ONLY the mobility period EXCLUDING the travel days,
- b) Be signed and stamped by the applicant and their Home University.

b) A CURRICULUM VITAE(CV) in Europass format

SELECTION PROCEDURE

- 1. Partner Universities will nominate staff via the e-nomination form.
- 2. All nominees will be sent guidelines on how they can apply for a mobility. The application will be submitted online according to the guidelines that will be sent.
- 3. After the deadline of applications, all applications will be assessed by the ECTS coordinators of our Schools and Units.
