




Caste System


- Bill Cosby has been publicly accused of raping, drugging, coercing or sexually assaulting 40 women since 1965, and many of them have only started to come forward since October 2014.
- The 78-year-old comedian hasn't been charged with any crimes stemming from the allegations, but over a decade after the first accuser went public, the world has increasingly taken notice. Many of Cosby's live performances have been canceled or postponed amid the avalanche of claims. Netflix postponed his special indefinitely and TV Land nixed "Cosby Show" reruns from its lineup.



The Upper Class




- This is about 5 % with income over \$205,000

% from each social class saying they are very satisfied with their ...




