

Information for students of the Pre-university course program arriving in Russia.

Dear student!

Kuban State University informs you about the steps to be taken after obtaining a Russian visa.

1. When a Russian consular issues you a study visa, you must immediately send a copy of it to the Head of the Preparatory Department and the Inspector of the International Affairs Department in charge of migration and registration issues.
2. Your visa specifies the terms of its validity. You need to enter the territory of the Russian Federation no later than 30 days before the visa expires. If it is impossible to arrive in Russia within the specified time, it is necessary to inform the Head of the Preparatory Department and the inspector of the International Affairs Department in charge of migration registration issues.
3. If you do not inform the University about applying for a visa for 20 days after receiving the invitation, the University will cancel your invitation and you will not be able to arrive in Russia.
4. For a smooth arrival at the University, it is necessary to send a copy of the airplane ticket to Russia no later than 10 business days before the expected date of entry to the Head of the Preparatory Department and the Inspector of the International Affairs Department in charge of migration and registration issues.
5. The student is obliged, after crossing the border of the Russian Federation, to arrive directly at the place of study and inform the employees of the International Affairs Department about the route, using the contact information specified in clause 6.
