4. specimen-an individual animal, plant, piece of a mineral, etc., used as an example of its species or type for scientific study or display.- образец,экземпляр
5. ripe- (of fruit or grain) developed to the point of readiness for harvesting and eating.-созревший,спелый
6. keep (one's) paws off (something or someone)- To refrain from touching or handling (something or someone). Usually said imperatively.
- 7.brolly-buster-n. British slang, "umbrella"
- 8.bucket down-: to rain very heavily-льет как из ведра

10. freshen up-to quickly wash yourself so that you feel clean-освежиться, привести себя в порядок

20. shipshape-in good order; trim and neat.-в полном порядке, аккуратно

21. do/make rounds- to go from one person or place to another- навещать, делать обход

22. play havoc with- to make a situation much more difficult or confusing/ -to damage something-нанести ущерб

23. heck of a sth/sb- =very/
one heck of a sth/sb a surprisingly good person or thing

24. to bring salvation- принести спасение, помочь

25. pull (one's) leg- To tease or joke with someone, often by trying to convince him or her of something untrue. -смеяться, высмеивать, подшучивать над кем-то

26. to pocket-picketing- to steal of money from someone

27. A duffel bag, - is a large cylindrical bag made of cloth (or other fabric), historically with a top closure using a drawstring.-спортивная сумка

28. take an oath-to make an oath; to swear to something- дать клятву

29. stick to something- to continue to do or use one particular thing and not change it or stop it for any period of time- придерживаться чего-то
